Question	Answer
1. We are a buy and for women's rights organisation and will be applying for the Domestic Abuse Workforce Programmes Evidence Fund (Strand 1). We are aware that there is a ring-fenced funding to strengthen the evaluation capacity of buy and for organisations (Strand 2). And there's two questions. 1. Will our Buy-and-For status impact our application to the Workforce Programme Evidence Fund? 2. Is there a restriction on how many funding calls we apply to?	1. No, any entity that meets the criteria as detailed in the call specifications is eligible. 2. No, however, the criteria for both strands is distinct. Strand 1 is targeting programmes which are evaluation ready, or near to evaluation ready. Whereas Strand 2 is about strengthening evaluation capacity skills. As such, we would not anticipate an organisation to fall under both strands. Though if there are further details on this content, do reach out to us.
